## Background


Histones are basic nuclear proteins that are responsible for the nucleosome structure of the chromosomal fiber in eukaryotes. Two molecules of each of the four core histones (H2A, H2B, H3, and H4) form an octamer, around which approximately 146 bp of DNA is wrapped in repeating units, called nucleosomes. The linker histone, H1, interacts with linker DNA between nucleosomes and functions in the compaction of chromatin into higher order structures. HIST1H2AI is intronless and encodes a replication-dependent histone that is a member of the histone H2A family. Transcripts from HIST1H2AI lack polyA tails but instead contain a palindromic termination element. HIST1H2AI is found in the small histone gene cluster on chromosome 6p22-p21.3.
